Donations to the non-supper supper brought the total to \$1327. Perhaps through Lent there will be motivation to reach the target. Other donations included \$700 from a partner church towards the West Ferris Community Brunch and \$220 as your “good will” offering for CL&W’s efforts with the ACM luncheon.

There were 47 families on PAR and 37 families used envelopes to support Emmanuel in February. The approved budget projects a deficit of \$18,699 and those attending the Annual Congregation Meeting are aware that collectively we need to reverse a trend of declining offerings. Offerings to M&S and Mortgage Funds continue to be less than our commitment. Offerings and donations (non-supper supper) to the general fund did not cover our local church expenses through February.

As we prepare to showcase Emmanuel’s “time” and “talent” through Easter and our Beef Supper please consider offering your “treasures” to sustain Emmanuel and United Church Canada.
