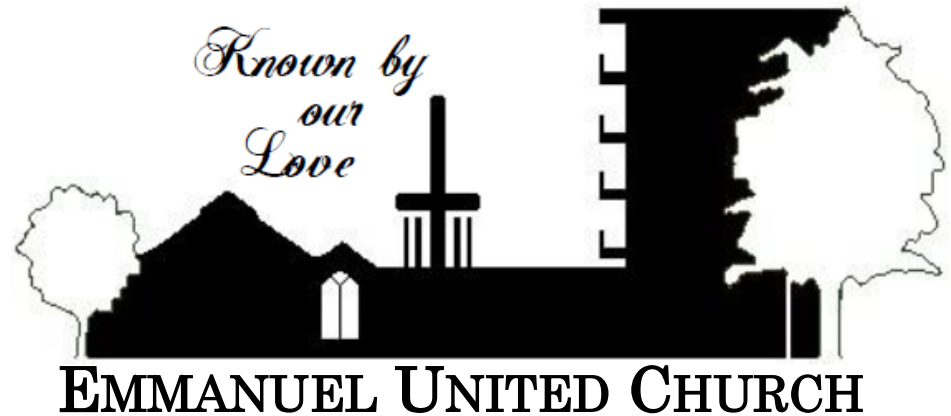

COMMUNITY EVENTS

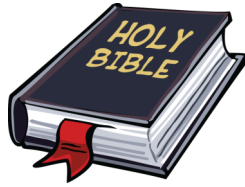
