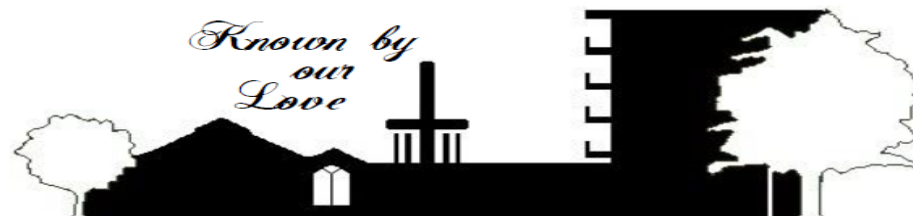
Choral Benediction:
