A Message From Rev. Roni

This Sunday we celebrate Emmanuel's 35th Anniversary of relocation to 395 Lakeshore Drive. I imagine that there was great joy and excitement about the possibility of being a village. We have weathered many storms and achieved many goals. It is has been a hard year, as we were forced to close our doors due to the pandemic. We can't gather in the building to celebrate this milestone. The original context of today's gospel reading, John 15: 1-8, is the end of Jesus' earthly ministry. The cross is at hand. Yet, Jesus offers a hopeful message.

Jesus employs the metaphor of a grape vine. He says that he is like that well-weathered vine that produces sap over the years and from which every vine finds its source. The most productive vines are those closest to the central vine.



My family home had a grape vine in the backyard and in the late fall we would remove the dead branches from the central vine. The pruning is necessary for a good crop of grapes.

The central vine wasn't much of a sight to behold, the outer bark looked withered and worn and yet new shoots came forth each spring and the ones closest to central vine produced the juiciest and most delicious grapes. We would have likely gotten more grapes if we had removed the unproductive branches, thereby forcing the more productive branches to produce more fruit. The purpose is to bear fruit. Branches that abide closest to the central vine are most productive.

On this 35th Anniversary, even as we view this service remotely, Jesus is still sending us a positive and hopeful message. May we be rooted once more in God's love and may we be empowered to bear the fruits of love. Being with Christ and responding in faith is essential to bearing the fruits of love.

Join us for online worship on Sunday May 2nd 2021. Please secure a candle or battery-operated candle, a piece of bread, rice cracker or bread like substance and juice or wine. We will celebrate virtually the sacrament of Holy Communion.
