Friends,

Did you ever wonder about the history of White Gift Sunday? I found this article published by St. Paul's Church in Ajax ON, which captures the history of this beloved tradition.

"The tradition of White Gift Sunday has its roots in a small Methodist church in Ohio in 1904. What began as a humble way to reflect on the love and devotion of the giver and not the value of the gift has grown into today's white gift services in many churches across several denominations. The story is told that a minister's wife initiated the idea to solve the problem of inequity of gifts given at the Sunday School Christmas party. Instead of focusing on receiving gifts, the focus shifted to bringing gifts to Jesus that could in turn be shared with people around the world who did not have much. All the gifts would come wrapped in plain white paper, so that no one would know which was an expensive gift and which was a more modest one. No one would feel ashamed of their gift and everyone would share in the joy of giving to others."

Here at Emmanuel United Church, we keep the spirit of the White Gift tradition alive by bringing gifts to support those who live with poverty. This year you are invited to donate personal care items (e.g. toothpaste, tooth brushes, soap, toilet paper and shampoo) suitable for men and women. Gift cards for No Frills and Giant Tiger are also

suitable items. Small things given with great love is what Christ's birth is all about. Thank you for doing what you can to share goodwill and peace to all.

Emmanuel also received an additional \$10,000 from the bequest towards the Legacy fund, our means to sustain Emmanuel and its mission.

The 11th annual "Cookie Walk" continued an Emmanuel tradition while respecting protocols to minimize risk. Imagine over 350dozen delicacies to choose from and over 100 participants baking, serving and enjoying the event. The reward also extends to former Emmanuel stalwarts through Visitation/Willing Workers and to regular customers of Emmanuel's Food Cupboard. The collective effort yielded \$1,864 to date in sales and donations. Thank you; it was fun, safe and rewarding.

With \$1,000 in support from Outreach, M&S offerings to the end of November totaled \$6,503 thus the year-end target (\$1,000) is achievable. There was \$100 in memorium towards the general fund and \$100 for the traditional Turkey Supper in November.

By the end of 2020 Avgen card sales will excess \$100,000 and Emmanuel's reward will approach \$4,000 over the 26 months it has existed. Please consider your opportunity to participate and experience the convenience.
