A Message From Rev. Roni

My grandmother used to say "if God brings you to it, God will see you through it". The statement places God at the center of the hard things that we face in this life. I have a degree of faith; however, at times I wonder if I have enough faith to cope with the really hard things: death of a parent or a spouse or life-threatening illness. I had enough faith to try watercolour this winter and I have enough faith to try bike riding this summer. I wonder, if I have enough faith to face the big challenges? My most honest answer is that I probably don't but I trust that Jesus would meet me there. In the moment, I would come to know in a very intimate way the grace of God, the goodness of God, God's mercy. In such difficult moments many people

have experienced God's presence in very intimate ways. I don't know if you might go as far as calling these experiences miracles?

In biblical times, such signs were understood to be miracles. Conversely, miracles are understood to be signs of God's presence. Let's try to remember that "miracles are to be understood as signs of God's presence. The goal of preaching on a miracle should not be to explain how this came to be, the goal is to reveal the sign-to draw the hearer closer to God's presence, to reveal God's presence.
