Our Church will be closed for the month of August for staff holidays but St. Andrews will be having Worship Services & you are welcome to attend or perhaps watch the Service online if they are doing that.

COVID-19 Procedures and Practices

Welcome back to your church home or temporary home! We are so happy you are here. Everyone's cooperation is essential in ensuring the health and safety of all. Some of these are legal requirements on your part and/or the church's part:

- Please notify the church by Friday Noon if possible, if planning to attend a service (for seating purposes) emmanuelunited@cogeco.net or 705-472-1806. The Greeter will either check off that you attended or add your name & phone number to the list.
- You must wear a facemask throughout the service and anywhere within the church building unless medically exempt.
- Please use the hand sanitizer provided, upon entering the church building. The Greeter at the William St. Entrance will give you a shot of sanitizer.
- Please maintain 2 meter social distancing from other people at all times.
- Please enter and leave the sanctuary through the main sanctuary doors only-keeping appropriate spacing
- Church name tags will not be used at this time, for sanitary reasons.
- Please place your offering into the container provided as you enter the sanctuary.
- Please use the seating that you are directed to by the usher. Do not rearrange the seating.
- Do not sing at any time during the service. You are welcome to take part in the spoken portions of the Service.
- Hymn books will not be used during the service.
- At the end of the service, you will be asked to exit starting from the back of the church as directed by the Usher(s). Please be patient.
- If you need to use the washroom during the service, please exit and re-enter through the main sanctuary doors.
- Do not enter any part of the church building that is cordoned-off or indicated by a "Do not enter" sign.

 If you feel ill or have any of the symptoms of covid19, do not attend services.

Please be considerate of the health and wellbeing of others.
