I grieve not being together and at the same time I celebrate that we have been doing online worship for the past four months. We have gotten more comfortable with leading in front of a camera and Lorne has developed an efficient process for editing and producing the video-based services. We have a good process in place.

If we are required to continue with online services in the fall, then we are over the learning curve. Heartfelt thanks are extended to Lorne Robertson, Elizabeth and John Henderson, Olivia Trottier, Bud McMartin, Bob and Betty Farris, and Elaine Simmens.

In preparation for the possibility of reopening, this week I called the North Bay Parry Sound Health Unit and was referred to the

COVID 19 guidelines for the reopening of places of worship. Most of our congregation (over seventy) are deemed high risk and the measures are very strict for the sake of the safety of our members and the community. Copies of the guidelines can be obtained through "the my health unit" website. I forwarded the guidelines to members of our church council. The directives are being experienced as overwhelming, so we ask you to keep an open mind. Allow council to do its work and keep enjoying the online worship experiences throughout the summer months. Our church council has not yet convened and no date has been set for resuming public worship. This week I am doing something different.
