## A Message From Rev. Roni

It's been a very difficult week. Our hearts are broken once again by the systemic evil of the Residential School System. At times such as these, the force of evil feels overwhelming. I believe at times such as these, we need to be reminded, that while the force of evil feels great, we can draw on an even greater force which is the power of God's healing love. Cords of love, justice and compassion can have a stronghold over evil.

At times such as these, when it seems like we have been in the trenches for way too long, it is helpful to remember that Jesus is with us in the struggle. More importantly, may we know in our hearts that God's love overpowers evil.

We can all do something: we can read more, we can listen to the stories of those who survived the residential school system, we can donate to the North Bay Indigenous Friendship Centre, and we can encourage our congregation to donate to the healing fund of the United Church of Canada. We can choose to listen and empathize with those who continue to suffer intergenerational trauma.

We may get called "names" or criticised at times for taking a radical stand, but we are not alone. Jesus was called "Beelzebul" which means "Prince of the Demons" Jesus is with us in the struggle and love wins. Please take time for your own self-care at this difficult time, your soul needs to be in touch with God's peace.

This week we will celebrate online communion, please prepare a piece of bread or a gluten free option and some juice or wine as you prepare to participate in our online service.
