Yesterday, March 11th, marked the one year anniversary of the COVID 19 Pandemic. Not too long after that we closed the doors of our churches, all of our worship service went online, schools went online, restaurants closed and all but essential businesses closed. Some say that the second wave, was the result of reopening the economy too quickly and soon our health care system became overwhelmed. We are just coming out of our second lockdown. Here in North Bay we are likely to stay in the red zone (restrict) for at least another week and neighbouring Sudbury has re-entered lockdown due a rise in variants of concern (VOC). The Worship Committee of Emmanuel United Church has decided to not reopen, until we are at least in the orange zone.

Maybe we made mistakes along the way, by reopening too soon. If we lived in Old Testament

times, it might be said that the rates of infection, death, and isolation that accompanies extended lockdowns, are God's judgement.
