A Message From Rev. Roni

During the season of Lent, I have taken on the challenge of preaching on some topics that I would traditionally avoid. This Sunday I am preaching on the theme of confession. Confession is defined as owning up to something you know or believe, and telling it forthrightly to all who should hear it. I have also heard it said that confession may be good for the soul, but it could be bad for your career! My theme sentence this week is, most of us are blind to our own shortcomings. I will be drawing an analogy from my personal life.

For one year of my adult life, I met with a psychotherapist for cognitive behavioural therapy to improve the quality of my personal relationships. It was almost instinctive to begin to rant about the shortcomings of others. My therapist, in his calm voice, would always bring me back to this question, "Now, what's your role in it?"

It takes great intentionality and discipline to deconstruct a scenario and claim your role in a conflicted relationship and the next step is to focus on that which you are empowered to change. It takes great vulnerability and trust to allow one's heart to be examined by a psychotherapist or God. Some suggest it is like allowing a trusted person to wash you. The good news is God is on the side of renewal. Confession is a step toward renewal. God is always safe.


