A Message From Rev. Roni

Palm Sunday on March 28th 2021, may feel like a non-event to you, as we are not gathering in-person. We were unable to celebrate in-person in 2020 and now in 2021, due to the pandemic. Many historians suggest that the Palm Parade in Jesus's day though energetic, it was comparatively small and its purpose was hidden from the hearts of the people in the crowd. Prophecies and ideas circulated that the Messiah would overthrow the oppressive Roman Empire. No one expected the Messiah to die a shameful death on a cross.

Did you know that there would have been a cavalry parade from Caesarea, a city named after the Roman Emperor, lead by Pilate on a white stallion, flanked by other soldiers, from the West gate? Jesus comes through the East gate. The purpose of the Calvary Parade was to intimidate and discourage any uprising. It was meant to let the people know who was in charge. Institutional power rules for a significant while casting a long shadow. Jesus does not take the kind of decisive strike the world anticipates.

Here is an interesting reflection by Henri Nouwen on the hiddenness of Jesus:

Jesus' Hiddenness

I don't think you'll ever be able to penetrate the mystery of God's revelation in Jesus until it strikes you that the major part of Jesus' life was hidden and that even the "public" years remained invisible as far as most people were concerned. Whereas the way of the world is to insist on publicity, celebrity, popularity, and getting maximum exposure, God prefers to work in secret. You must let that mystery of God's secrecy, God's anonymity, sink deeply into your consciousness because, otherwise, you're continually looking at it from the wrong point of view. In God's sight the things that really matter seldom take place in public. . . . Maybe, while we focus our whole attention on the VIPs and their movements, on peace conferences and protest demonstrations, it's the totally unknown people, praying and working in silence, who make God save us yet again from destruction.
