## A Message From Rev. Roni

Dear Friends.

I hope that you are all persevering and being patient as we continue to be safe during this current lockdown. Most of us, have likely not been with our friends for a while, so this illustration may feel like a remote stretch. Have you ever been introduced to someone as someone's friend "friend of a friend"? Somehow, having a friend in common really helps to establish our credibility and we find ourselves being received a little more openly. In this Sunday's gospel reading Jesus calls us friend. It is humbling that Jesus, the Saviour calls us friend, and likewise all of Jesus followers become friends of a great friend. Jesus's friendship includes those that we are not likely to invite to our homes for a backyard barbeque. Who might Jesus have us include?

I was reminded by a colleague this week, that while we will all celebrate Mother's Day this Sunday, we might not remember that it is Asian Heritage Month and we might be tempted to overlook the contributions of Asians to culture of North Bay and Northern Ontario.

Perhaps it is even more important to educate ourselves about the ways in which our Asian neighbours reflect Christ's love and light. Since 2017, North Bay's South Asian population has grown. 45 + from India, 30 from Syria, 30 from the Philippines, 20 from China and 20 from Vietnam. Most of North Bay's newest immigrants are Asian. Many of us in North Bay, came to embrace Rev. Jong Bok Kim and his wife Julie as beloved. I am sure that beyond their contribution our knowledge of Asian contributions in North Bay may be limited. More recently, with the onset of Covid 19 Asians have been negatively profiled and many have faced increased racial discrimination.

Our Asian neighbours are friends of our great friend Jesus. Jesus' love and compassion includes each one as beloved. We are all challenged to get to know our Asian sisters and brothers for we are all friends in Christ. We are all friends of a great friend.

Join us for Online Worship this week, Sunday May 9th at 10:30 am. Our scripture passages this week are Psalm 98 and John 15:9-17. Our theme is "Jesus Calls Us Friend".

Happy Mother's Day to all the moms and those who give the gift of motherly nurture!
