A Message From Rev. Roni

Last week the National Office of the United Church of Canada released a vague three phase plan for the re-opening of churches. No date has been set and the United Church of Canada and our Regional Council office are listening to the Public Health experts and Federal and provincial directives. Our Regional Council will advise us on dates and protocols for reopening. We know that things will be very different: we would have limitations on the size of our gatherings, social distancing will be in effect, some of us will be wearing masks and we will not be able to sing. Droplets from singing travel a long distance and are a major health risk. We will have no choirs. We most likely will have no coffee hour.

These changes will be unprecedented and we will feel a sense of loss and disorientation. Feeling sad is perfectly okay. We likely will be doing online congregational worship for a long-time. Our Regional Council will advise us on the process.

We will grieve some losses and we might feel adrift for a while, for a long while. In this week's Gospel reading, Jesus reminds us that we will not be left adrift or orphaned. God will send the Holy Spirit to lead us into all truth. God's love will never leave us. Love is God's reality. Our feelings are real and God is choosing to be in real time relationship with us.
