A Message From Rev. Roni

I participated in my first and only flash mob at the Parliament of World Religions in November 2018. It was energizing and exhilarating and sucked me in, like a vacuum. I couldn't resist the pulsing beat of the drums and joyful singing in the square. Even if you just kept walking you couldn't escape its pulsing beat and rhythm that filled that atrium at Toronto's Metro Convention Centre. Many of you might remember watching a live "flash mob" on you tube. It became popular over 2010-2019. It is usually staged in a public place. Typically there is some kind of common song or common experience. The location can vary from an outdoor space (a large square or park), a food court in a shopping mall, or an atrium of some sort. Some elements of it are staged and some are spontaneous. You might describe it as an explosive burst of energy and it's surprising!

Some people join right in with the song or dance, some are awed, some just try to go on as if nothing has happened, and some might even be confused. You might describe Pentecost, as God's flash mob. It takes place fifty days after the Passover, if you believe that Jesus died close to Passover, then roughly fifty days after Easter and ten days, after Jesus became a cosmic presence at the Ascension. God is staging this flash mob: the wind, the tongues of fire ...it's all intentional, even the setting, it's all staged by God and all packed with symbolism. It's a public event. Join us as we remember God's flash mob, virtually on Sunday May 31st 2020. It will be posted on You Tube!
