## A Message From Rev. Roni

This Easter will be very different from any other that I can remember. We are advised to socially distance and stay home. Maybe you are feeling a bit sad. I was comforted by the message of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II, a few days ago.

Whether you are a royal monarchist, or a royal anarchist, you have to agree that Queen Elizabeth, a woman who has lived through many crises, is a credible voice. She has lived through Two World Wars and the Spanish flu and she knows that we will get to the other end of this crisis, if we do our part. She acknowledged the hardness of this time and told us that we will all share in the success.
