### A Note From Rev. Roni

In the season of spring, it can be easier to talk about resurrection because crocuses are blooming and young shoots are pushing up through once frozen ground, and I have even seen patches of green grass. New life is sprouting all around us. It's obvious, seeing is believing.

However, not all seasons of life, are so obvious, teeming with clear evidence of life. Sometimes pain wears us down. At other times, our hearts might be broken by grief and unspeakable loss.

A young woman comes to the local gym where I am a member, I deeply admire her dedication and commitment to exercise. I can see her channelling determination and energy in each rep. At first, I didn't notice. As she turned toward me, it became more obvious, she was an amputee, her entire left arm had been amputated from the shoulder. She exercises without a prosthesis, and has learned to adapt her exercises around her

disability. She chooses life, she chooses belief, pushing past her emotional and physical discomfort with a determination to return to exercise. I've since spoken to her, applauding her courage. Beaming with a smile, she responds "I'll never be able to go back to what I did before this happened to me. But I'll exercise in whatever way I can." She chooses life. Maybe the believing comes first, then we can see. Believing isn't always easy. I am sure my friend at the gym, has had difficult days, when everything seemed harder, when she felt sad and even disappointed. Jesus blesses our believing even on the bad days. The sign that Thomas receives, helps us to believe when we have difficulty seeing. Join us for worship on this Second Sunday of Easter at 10:30 am, we will welcome three persons into our community of faith: two through baptism and one through reaffirmation of faith.
