As a follow-up to a book study on "White Fragility", sponsored by the Mission Cluster of North Bay and area united churches, which included a staff person from the Multicultural Centre, we were astounded to learn of the multiple experiences of racism here in North Bay. Our group felt motivated to reach out to Mr. Rota's office and our Prime Minister as allies in dealing with racism in Canada.

On November 28th, Arlene Hummel, Kathie Smith and yours truly were warmly welcomed by Micheline (Mr. Rota's Executive Assistant) and later by Mr. Rota, where we were treated to a very pleasant visit in his office.



We talked about our shared reflections and commitment to unlearning racism. Mr. Rota's journey is distinct, as a first generation Italian-Canadian who experienced some discrimination in his early years. We offered to

reflect with him, as he reads the book and he seemed very receptive that we progressives unknowingly engage in systemic racism. It's about naming not blaming. We all acknowledged the work of self-awareness in turning away from a past of systemic racism. It's in our nation's history. The church plays a role in announcing God's coming judgment. God's peaceable kingdom includes everyone. God's peaceable North Bay includes racialized persons and new immigrants. The church is the saving judge of the world's culture.
