## Will you be able to join us?

Eat with friends, then stay for the meeting to learn what your church plans for the coming year. Have you ever wondered, how do you know that you've made a good choice? It often isn't so clear cut. How do you know that you have been obedient to God's law of love? Our old testament reading, one of Moses's last sermons, given while the people are on the brink of crossing the Jordan and about to enter the Promised Land, if taken literally, suggest that you can follow God's law and make a good choice and choose life, or you can make a bad choice, follow a false deity and choose death. Most of us know that a bad choice, won't always lead to death but can create lots of turbulence in our lives and in the lives of those we love. It is often hard to know if a decision is actually good, it isn't always so black or white.

In my life I have made good and bad choices. Through the practice of spiritual direction I have learned three guiding questions that can help us make faithful choices: Is it good for me? Is it good for community? Is it good for God? Beyond wrestling with these questions we are called to obedience. "Obedience is not merely doing as one is told. Obedience is a discernment process that involves not only the mind and will but also, and more especially the heart (Feasting on the Word, Year A Volume 1, pg, 340)." I hope you will join in our time of reflection.
