Invitations to our "Non-Supper Supper" were well received. Within the first month there were 40 reservations (\$1,890) and arrangements are complete to accommodate many more. All participants benefit from the spiritual and physical warmth it yields.

The February 23rd tally featured \$215 generated by 3 families providing food and fellowship, a chilli smorgasbord, following the Service. The "Animation Team" is focused on our fundamental mission; and, processes are in place to support expressions of interest on new and expanded endeavours. Other ideas and offers of "time" and "talent" in pursuit of our mission are welcome.

Avgen pre-paid cards generated \$68 and a challenge to expand participation has been issued, Please embrace the opportunity and place an order. The deadline for the next order is March 8th, 2020.

Except for \$672 (M&S offerings) all the above revenue is to sustain Emmanuel. There was \$50 "in memorium" and \$82 in Offerings to the Legacy Fund which will assist in offsetting local church expenses now and in the future.

The total revenue in February (\$9,314) was less than expenses. The \$13,000 cushion to start the year (Legacy Fund provision) is quickly eroding. While the number of families on PAR declined by two, there was increased support through envelope offerings.

Finance has compiled 2020 Budget estimates as required and initiated discussion on strategies to "right size" and live within our means. You are welcome to attend the March 16th meeting. Congregation will set the Budget and select the leadership team at the ACM scheduled for March 29th, 2020.
