A Note From Rev. Roni

The caption for this week's gospel reading is called "the Call of the First Disciples". The study of this passage prompted me to reflect on my early call to ministry, back to the early days in 2000 when I first heard God's call. It was as clear as a bell, "I want to you connect church and community."

I had much to learn, with opportunities for growth, and my sense of call has deepened as I served from one community to the next: Martingrove united Church (North Etobicoke), Humbervale United Church (Central Etobicoke), St. James-Bond United Church (North Toronto), Knox United Church-Agincourt (Scarborough), Erin Mills United Church (Mississauga), Churchill Meadows (Mississauga), Wellington Square United Church (Burlington), Trinity United

Church and Sugarbush Christian Church (Guelph) and Emmanuel United Church (ordained minister, North Bay.

Each place, came with an invitation to risk with Jesus, to step into the unknown and experience God's blessing-God's ordaining. Like the first disciples, much of my learning has been on-the-job training. In the risking together we experience God's blessing.
