#### Sustaining Families 47(PAR); 23 Envelopes

The total revenue in January (\$6,872) was considerably lower than previous years. It represents 36% of the revenue reported last month. When one considers the average monthly costs paid by EUC in 2019 was \$12,270 there is reason for concern.

On a positive note the January 26<sup>th</sup> donations include proceeds from the Avgen pre-paid cards <u>plus</u> Emmanuel's <u>first-ever</u> on-line donation through "Canada Helps" website. Emmanuel is in the process of finalizing details to welcome and receive support respecting upcoming generations affinity for online payments.

In memorium donations provided \$75 for local church expenses and \$160 to the Memorial Fund.

Finance met January 16<sup>th</sup> to review Emmanuel's records for 2019 and Committee projections for 2020. The figures were provided to Council. The projected shortfall in revenue for 2020 exceeds accessible reserves. Further teamwork and responsible planning is necessary before presenting a budget to the Congregation for approval.
