I'd like to further suggest that the 23rd Psalm gives us reason to be thankful, for God satisfies our deepest needs. The noise of the world, the many voices makes it hard to differentiate our needs from our compulsions.

In times of stress, we struggle to discern what we actually need from our own insecurities, or those perpetuated from the society and the media. Politicians sometimes appeal to our fears. Advertisers appeal to our insecurities about our looks, whether or not we come across as successful, are we sexy? Psalm 23 reminds us. 'Emmanuel United Church, God is our shepherd, we shall not go wanting, our needs are met for this day and everyday.' "Needs met, for now." Glory to God whose mercy is abundant.
