The profit after all the bills were paid, was \$5,891.11 and that, added to the \$1,189.00 from those 20 turkeys that were 'saved', and miscellaneous monies received in donations, gave us a net profit of \$7,080.11. A cheque for \$6,000.00 was given to the church.

One of my favourite getaway places here in West Ferris, is hanging out at the local legion #599. From time to time, Lorne and I have gone for a cold drink. My best preparation for a service such as the upcoming Remembrance Day involves getting to know the veterans by listening to their stories. It is quite the sacrifice to leave a country like Canada where you enjoy personal freedoms and privileges and embed yourself in a region of the world destabilized by war and violence. I think of the vastness and divergence of life experiences and the messiness of it all-being deployed to a battle zone or a place torn apart by war. I consider the trauma and the opportunity to be in relationship as their chaplain.

My heart is warmed when they share stories of shared humanity: sensitivity to people of other cultures, kindness and compassion. I am reminded of Jesus whom God chose to send on a peace mission here on earth. I am reminded that peacemaking and conviction hinges on humility. Jesus humbled himself. Perhaps our warring world needs to learn this practice of humility.
