The Afterlife and Near-Death Experiences. Have you ever wondered what happens after you die? Have you ever wondered where your lost loved-ones might be right now? Emmanuel will be hosting a study, led by Lorne Robertson and Janie Clayton, on what are called near-death experiences or NDE's. These are the experiences of people who were clinically dead and resuscitated, or who came so close to dying that they believed they were doomed and experienced some of the same things as those who actually experienced clinical death. These stories hold out what, in my mind, is the most compelling evidence for both an afterlife and the existence of God.
