The Afterlife and Near-Death Experiences

Have you ever wondered what happens after you die? Have you ever wondered where your lost loved-ones might be right now? Perhaps you are a skeptic and think there is no afterlife. Perhaps you believe in a traditional Christian perspective of heaven and hell, where heaven is a walled city with pearly gates and streets paved in gold and hell is a fiery place of eternal damnation. Perhaps you believe some combination of these perspectives wherein you are truly dead and unaware until raised again on judgement day. Whatever you believe, the bible has woefully little to say about what the afterlife is actually like. In fact, there is. In this era of modern medicine, there are people who have, literally, returned from the dead. Some of these people can recall being dead and there is a

remarkable similarity in the stories they bring back with them. Emmanuel will be doing a study, led by Lorne Robertson and Janie Clayton, on what are called near-death experiences or NDE's. These are the experiences of people who were clinically dead and resuscitated, or who came so close to dying that they believed they were doomed and experienced some of the same things as those who actually experienced clinical death. Do not be afraid, though, you will not find these stories morbid, but uplifting. These stories hold out what, in my mind, is the most compelling evidence for both an afterlife and the existence of God. Please join us for four weekly sessions, starting at 6:30 pm November 5th, 2019.
