A Note From Rev. Roni

My neighbour John asked me a very good question last night. He enquired whether I was aware of the photo and news report that surfaced of Prime Minister Justin Trudeau painting his face brown, brown-facing for an Arabian Night themed costume party in 2001. I responded that I saw the news and I was shocked. Mr. Trudeau has espoused diversity and spoken against racism and declared himself to be an ally. I thought he lived what he professed. Now, I have questions about his self-awareness. He is seeking forgiveness. I want to know whether he has taken steps to unlearn racism.

In response to John's question, I would ask Mr. Trudeau, Do you understand the history of black-facing? Do you understand the history of racism in Canada? Are you self-aware of your unearned power and privilege? When did you become self-aware of your power and privilege? Have you done antiracism training? Do you own the values you espouse?

He can never undo what he has done in the past. How has he grown? Has he done his work? Does he understand the antiracism lingo he uses? What is his understanding? I am hoping that a greater maturity may emerge; one in which he is willing to let the God of justice and introspection deal with him. After all, maturation in a spiritual sense is a growing willingness to stretch out my arms, to have a belt put round me, and to be led where I would rather not go (John 21:18). Taking the time to stop and say sorry and ask for forgiveness is a good start but more is needed. It takes courage to engage in self-examination. It reguires humility and a commitment to justice. Grace is needed. He sounds a little like a dishonest manager, maybe more like a questionable manager, which happens to be the gospel reading for Sunday, September 22nd, 2019. I may just preach on the Old Testament on Sunday and stay away from politics.
